



## Letting Rates

*The Village Hall is a non-profit-making facility managed and maintained by Community Volunteers. The affordable letting rates reflect that contribution.*

*Rates are inclusive of energy used for heating, lighting and food preparation.*

### Registered Community Groups

Main Hall Only	£10.00/h
Meeting Room	£5.00/h
Social Room	£5.00/h

Registered Community Groups qualify for a discounted rate by contributing to the running of The Village Hall – specifically – “Contributing to periodic work parties and fund raising towards purchase of facilities, not considered to be part of normal maintenance but as an asset intended for use by their group”.

Each RGC can nominate a representative to attend Village Hall Management Meetings. RCGs must be non-commercial and non-profit making.
