



Minutes of the ordinary meeting of the Rowney Green Association Status 1st May 2021

Note: Due to Covid restrictions on meetings and reduced activities, it was agreed to issue a status only at this time.

1. Minutes of last meeting

The minutes of the last meeting on 2nd March were approved by email, as written.

2. Matters arising

All are covered below.

3. Treasurer's report

There is £1,871.31 in the bank and £174.74 cash in hand. £35 contribution towards the village lockdown memorial book was approved in July 2020 but remains unpaid to date, awaiting an invoice.

4. Membership

It was confirmed that 122 out of 195 houses in the village are members of the RGA, ('Old Garden' has been added). The collection of membership subscriptions falling due in 2020/1 has been reviewed and the Executive Committee have agreed to continue to suspend collections until it is safe to do so at which point a reminder will be issued to the households concerned. 59 subscriptions are currently outstanding.

5. Planning Update

Following the death of HRH Prince Philip, the APC Planning Committee was cancelled. An update will be provided at the July meeting.

6. Crime issues

Neighbourhood Watch is generally quiet. The only incidents include the theft of a caravan from Radford Farm which was later recovered and a report of suspicious behaviour around Seechem Manor in the early hours of the morning.

7. Council issues

The badly damaged drain cover in Lower Rowney Green was replaced in April but drainage by the Dell, Gravel Pit Lane and on the hill on Rowney Green Lane remain a concern. The Chair has written to C Hotham (WCC) requesting support with these issues but a response is unlikely before the upcoming elections.

It was agreed to postpone the AGM until after lockdown.
